

# Eagle Path Milestones

- [ ✓ ] 1. Meet with Eagle Coach to discuss timeline for obtaining Eagle Scout Rank  
(Milestones 1-11 must be completed by the scout's 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.)
  - [ ✓ ] 2. Attend Eagle Project Training Meeting
  - [ \* ] 3. Select Eagle Project and Complete Project Proposal document
  - [ \* ] 4. Acquire Signatures for Eagle Project Proposal (in this order):
    - a. Beneficiary
    - b. Unit Leader / Eagle Coach
    - c. Pacific Skyline Council Representative
  - [ ✓ ] 5. Complete Final Project Proposal (and optionally sign off Fundraising Approval)
  - [ ✓ ] 6. Acquire Comments for Final Project from Eagle Coach
  - [ \* ] 7. Obtain Activity Plan Approval for all Project workdays via MyScouting.org
  - [ \* ] 8. Begin and Complete Eagle Project Work
  - [ \* ] 9. Complete Project Write up with signatures (in this order):
    - a. Beneficiary
    - b. Unit Leader / Eagle Coach
  - [ \* ] 10. Complete Eagle Scout Application (Preparation for Eagle Scoutmaster and BOR)
    - a. Write up Req.# 7 and attach to application ( See Outline)
    - b. Make sure there is 6 months of leadership position
    - c. Obtain advancement form from Advancement Chair showing all merit badges earned. Work with Adv. Chair and Council to get dates correct.
    - d. Cross out Required Merit Badges not earned
  - [ \* ] 11. Participate in Eagle Scoutmaster Conference (Preparation for BOR)
    - a. Acquire Scoutmaster's signature
    - b. Acquire Committee Chair signature
    - c. Take Eagle Binder to Boy Scout Center – Either in Palo Alto or Foster City.
  - [ \* ] 12. Participate in Pacific Skyline Eagle Scout Board of Review
    - a. Usually on fourth Thursday of month if Paperwork in by 1st of month (except in November and December it is the third week due to holidays.)
    - b. Obtain any other Council signatures needed
